WHAT IS A DISCIPLE

The Greek word means pupil or student. It is a word frequently used in the New Testament and it describes a conscious decision to follow a teacher or a group. Basically, in ancient times a disciple was like an apprentice.

John 8:31

If you abide in My Word, you are My disciples indeed.

Mark 3:13-14

- 13 And He went up on the mountain and called to *Him* those He Himself wanted. And they came to Him.
- 14 Then He appointed twelve, that they might be with Him and that He might send them out to preach,


and to have power to heal sicknesses and to cast out demons

Being a disciple of Jesus means:

- Being called by Jesus,
- Being with Him,
- Being empowered and sent out by Him to preach the Gospel.









"I am the true vine, and My Father is the vinedresser.



Abide in Me, and I in you. As the branch cannot bear fruit of itself, unless it abides in the vine, neither can you, unless you abide in Me.

"I am the vine, you are the branches. He who abides in Me, and I in him, bears much fruit; for without Me you can do nothing.


If anyone does not abide in Me, he is cast out as a branch and is withered; and they gather them and throw them into the fire, and they are burned.


If you abide in Me, and My words abide in you, you will ask what you desire, and it shall be done for you.

By this My Father is glorified, that you bear much fruit; so you will be My disciples.


"As the Father loved Me, I also have loved you; abide in My love.

Every branch in Me that does not bear fruit He takes away; and every branch that bears fruit He prunes, that it may bear more fruit.



...Abiding in Christ means a constant receiving of His Spirit, a life of unreserved surrender to His service. The channel of communication must be open continually between man and his God.

As the vine branch constantly draws sap from the living vine, so are we to cling to Jesus, and receive from Him by faith the strength and perfection of His own character."

THIRD SIGN

A Disciple of Jesus bears fruit. Through his life and words the believer testifies to the changing power of Jesus Christ.

(Desire of Ages, pg. 676)




FOURTH SIGN

A disciple of Jesus lives according to the word of God.
